Getting to StoneX Stadium

StoneX Stadium is easy to get to with several transport options including car, train, London Underground, bus and local cycle routes. Fans can reach StoneX Stadium in just 25 minutes from Central London.



by Car

StoneX Stadium is easily accessed by car being just 400 metres from Junction 2 of the M1, 12 minutes inside the M25 and right next to the A1. There are several car parks in the vicinity of the Stadium that can be booked via eticketing.co.uk/saracens ahead of a matchday. Parking must be booked in advance.

The StoneX Stadium Post Code is NW4 1RL or alternatively, StoneX Stadium can be found using What3Words: ///invest.mobile.flank.



by Train

The nearest train station to StoneX Stadium is Mill Hill Broadway, on Thameslink, which is a 5-minute taxi journey from StoneX Stadium or 25-minute walk. It is 17 minutes to Mill Hill Broadway from King's Cross St Pancras, or 20 minutes from Farringdon. The free Saracens matchday shuttle buses run approximately every ten minutes from Mill Hill Broadway station.



by Tube

Mill Hill East tube station is on the Northern Line, and can be reached within 20 minutes from Kings Cross Station. StoneX Stadium is served by the Saracens free matchday shuttle bus service – leaving every ten minutes from the station – or is a seven-minute taxi journey away. Alternatively, fans can walk to StoneX Stadium from Mill Hill East in 25 minutes. <Edgware>



by Bus

The 221 bus route runs from Edgware bus station to Turnpike Lane station. Alight at the Copthall Sports Centre bus stop for StoneX Stadium, approximately a 10-minute walk away. The 113 bus route runs from Edgware bus station to Marble Arch. Alight at Five Ways Corner and StoneX Stadium is just a ten-minute walk away.

FREE MATCHDAY SHUTTLE BUSES

On home matchdays Saracens runs free shuttle buses from Mill Hill East and Edgware London Underground stations as well as Mill Hill Broadway National Rail station. Services are regular, running approximately every 10 minutes from each of these stations and drops fans a short walk from the stadium on Pursley Road. Pioneers will be present to help you find the buses and direct you towards StoneX Stadium.

Frequently Asked Questions

We want everyone to enjoy their matchday experience watching Saracens at StoneX Stadium. Below are some frequently asked questions which you may find useful ahead of your visit. If you have any further questions, please do not hesitate to contact our dedicated Supporter Services team via supporterservices@saracens.net

Where can I find my match ticket(s)?

You do not need to print your tickets, you can either download your barcoded tickets to your phone using the Apple or Google wallet links contained in your email or present the PDF tickets that are attached to your email.

Match tickets are sent via email and from either of the following email addresses: 'noreply@saracens.net' or 'noreply@ticketmaster.co.uk'. Please note that you are not able to download tickets from your online account. If you cannot locate your ticket(s) in your email inbox, please check your Junk/Spam folder. If you are still unable locate your ticket(s), please contact our Supporter Services team supporterservices@saracens.net

You can opt to download your tickets to your phone using the Apple or Google wallet links contained in your email, or use the PDF tickets that are attached to your email. You do not need to print your tickets - our Pioneers will be able to scan your tickets on arrival as long as you have a clear, uncracked phone screen.

If you are not able to download or print your ticket(s), our Supporter Services team can print them for you at the Ticket Office located to the left of Gate B. The Ticket Office opens two and a half hours before kickoff. Please note that there is a charge of £2.00 per ticket for this service.

How can I forward my Seasonal Membership to a friend for a fixture?

All Seasonal Memberships are transferable, and Seasonal Members are encouraged to share their Seasonal Membership with friends and family when they are unable to attend fixtures themselves. For a guide on how to transfer your Seasonal Membership, [please click here](#).

I've forgotten to bring my Seasonal Membership card to the match - what should I do?

We recommend that you download your digital Seasonal Membership card to your digital wallet on your mobile phone prior to attending your first fixture of the 2024/25 season. If you forget your card; you will still have the digital version to use. If you are unable to use a digital Membership Card, please visit the Ticket Office at Gate B where our Supporter Services team can print a paper ticket for your Seasonal Membership seat. The Ticket Office opens two and a half hours before kick-off. There is a charge of £2.00 per ticket for this service.

Where is the Ticket Office at StoneX Stadium?

The matchday Ticket Office is located next to Gate B at StoneX Stadium and opens two and a half hours before kick-off for ticket collection and matchday sales (subject to availability). Payments can be made by credit or debit card.

How do I access the seats in the upper level of the 1876 Stand (WU blocks)?

The upper level of the 1876 Stand is accessed via the stand's main entrance at the centre of the building. On approaching StoneX Stadium, do not enter using Gates B or C, but follow the path around to the front of the stand.

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the babes in arms policy at StoneX Stadium?

Children under 2 who do not occupy a seat are admitted free of charge at StoneX Stadium.

Children aged 2 and over are required to hold a match-day or season ticket.

Can I bring a pushchair to StoneX Stadium?

Yes, pushchairs are allowed in the stadium.

Please note that there is no designated buggy parking. If you need to leave your buggy, please ask a Pioneer to help locate a suitable place and be prepared to collapse it if required.

Who do I contact to make arrangements regarding accessibility needs on a matchday?

Our dedicated Supporter Services team will be able to assist with any queries you may have around accessible needs on a matchday at StoneX Stadium. Please contact them via supporterservices@saracens.net or 020 3870 3303.

What methods of payment can I use at StoneX Stadium?

Please note that StoneX Stadium is a cashless venue. Card payments only are accepted at all outlets.

What do I do if I lose an item on a matchday at StoneX Stadium?

If you believe that you have lost an item in or around StoneX Stadium, please contact lost property via supporterservices@saracens.net or 020 3870 3303. We advise that you contact us as soon as possible as we are not able to hold items found on matchdays indefinitely.

Can I re-enter the ground if I have exited?

Yes, re-entry is permitted but you must have had your ticket or Seasonal Membership card scanned out on exit in order to be allowed back into StoneX Stadium.

Can I smoke at StoneX Stadium?

StoneX Stadium is a non-smoking venue and anyone who would like to smoke (including e-cigarettes and vapes) will need to exit the Stadium boundary via any Gate.

Is there a matchday programme that I can purchase at the game?

Yes. Matchday programmes will be available to purchase for all Men's Gallagher Premiership and Investec Champions Cup fixtures at StoneX Stadium.

Are there any items that I am not allowed to bring in on a matchday?

Yes. A full list of prohibited items can be found [here](#) and includes the following: bottles, cans and beverages of any kind, food items, chairs or stools, knives, large umbrellas, laser pointers and video cameras.
